

Tuition All students and parents must fill out and sign a registration form/payment agreement on the reverse side of this paper. All students sign up for dance on a yearly basis (Sept-June), and understand that the financial obligation. You have the month of September to withdraw from dance classes and receive a refund, less registration, costume and fees for classes taken. The dancer, their parent or guardian are responsible for paying any collection or legal fees related to uncollected tuition fees. Checks returned for insufficient funds are subject to a \$25 additional fee. **LATE FEE, Transfer Fee, Processing Fees** of \$25 per month will be assessed to all indicated accounts.

Registration Fee: There is a one time non-refundable registration fee of \$20 per year, per student.

Costume Fee: Costumes are to be paid for at the time of registration and are a non-refundable cost. Costumes are not given to students who do not participate in the end of year dance concert even if they have been paid for. Costumes fees are not assessed for hip hop and/or modern classes – these classes purchase their own costumes at the end of the year.

Acting, Voice, Musical Theater, Performing Artists and Music Instrumentation Privates, Choreography, Master Classes & Workshops: Costs for private lessons vary on the instructor and amount of time. Approximate cost can range from \$40 - \$75 per hour for privates. All Private Classes are paid for on a monthly basis. Cost for Master Classes and Workshops vary on instructor, length of class and amount of students. All session and semester classes are paid for in full at the time of registration. Fees for these classes are indicated in the appropriate brochure. These classes are paid for in full at the beginning of each series, session or semester. There will be no refunds for these classes after the first class – no exceptions to this policy.

Class Placement Dancers will be placed in class (leveled) by their instructors. New students will be asked to take a placement or evaluation class prior to class assignment. Returning students are leveled by their instructors for the upcoming dance year during May. You may request a private evaluation.

Free Trial Classes FREE trial classes are given in dance and in voice, musical theater and acting with the instructor's approval.

Year End Performance We make every effort to keep the cost of our performances reasonable (costumes, programs, tickets, venue, etc.) The performance will be kept to a reasonable amount of time. The date for the year end is Saturday, June 16, 2012 at the Klein Memorial Auditorium in Bridgeport.

Class changes or cancellations The faculty reserves the right to place or move students according to technical ability throughout the year. Instructors may be changed due to conflicts in schedules. Classes may be cancelled due to insufficient enrollment.

Students and parents/guardians release claims of liability while studying dance, voice, acting, music instrumentation, musical theater, theater production or performing at PACC (Performing Arts Center of Connecticut, LLC) or at any of its venues.. PACC considers this registration form as full disclosure and information to its students and parents/guardians that we are not responsible for students once they leave class/instruction, even if the student remains at our facility. Parents and/or guardians assume complete responsibility and liability for students' transportation to and from classes and the manner in which that occurs. There is always a faculty member on the premises during scheduled class time and a phone in the main lobby for student use. Students may interrupt class for advice and/or questions related to health issues, accidents or pick up and drop off issues. PACC is **not** responsible for decisions made by students and or their parents/guardians. Signature of this registration form is considered full release of liability and acknowledgement of all the above.
