We have approximately 12,000 square feet of air-conditioned, state of the art space, which includes 4 dance studios (2- 1,000 sf, 1-1,500 sf and 1-2,400 sf), sprung floors and the latest professional audio systems, four voice/acting/music studios, 2 lounges, a homework/kitchen area, costume shop, acting/musical theater room, company lounge and our own black box theater.
